Dear Mayor and Council:

We recommend the council approve Change Order No. 2 regarding the change in substantial completion for lift stations 13T and 31T, the extension of the final completion date, and the deletion of the construction of lift station 25T due to permit delays.

The contractor was not able to take delivery of the generators for lift stations 13T and 31T until the end of November due to the availability of parts to build the generators to the specifications. This delay required a change to the substantial completion for those lift stations until the generators were installed and tested. The generators were tested and put into operation on December 27, 2023. The substantial completion date for all other lift stations remains at September 1, 2023. The final completion date change is needed for the contractor to restore the gas service trenches at 13T and 31T as well as restore lift stations that did not grow during the drought conditions of 2023.

Lift station 25T was not able to be constructed under the contact due to permit delays from the MNDNR and federal government for the new electrical service for the lift station. Since materials had already been purchased prior to knowing that there would be delays to the permitting for the lift station, it was decided by public works to purchase all the materials for the lift station and have them delivered to the City for installation and construction under another contract, once permit approval is granted in 2024.

WHEREAS, the City promotes the health, safety and welfare of all residents and recognizes the need to review proposed privately-sponsored events to prevent disturbances, nuisances, or potential risks to life, health and property, disruption to traffic or threatened damage to private or public property; and

WHEREAS, the City requires lake access approval and a permit for events to minimize the event's negative impact upon the health, safety, welfare of the general public, and the related government services including but not limited to fire department, law enforcement, transportation systems, and utilities; and

WHEREAS, the City collects information regarding privately-sponsored public events through issuance of a City of Forest Lake Event Permit ("Event Permit") application, that in turn is reviewed and approved by the City; and

WHEREAS, Jill Graven representing Kids Pro Ice ("Event Organizer") desires to hold a public event to be called Kids Pro Ice Racing to be held on Saturday, February 17, 2024 at/on Forest Lake First Lake ("Event"); and

WHEREAS, the Event Organizer has submitted required information to the City to hold the Event; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the Event Organizer's submitted materials, the City has approved the Forest Lake First Lake access with the following conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Forest Lake, State of Minnesota, that the Kids Pro Ice is granted access to Forest Lake First Lake, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The Event shall not include any activities not identified on the Event Permit application and site plan. All permitted Event activities shall be in locations as identified on the submitted site plan.
- 2. Access to Forest Lake First Lake shall be permitted through the City's boat launch in Lakeside Memorial Park at the Event Organizer's own risk. Event Organizer shall not

- alter in any manner or block the boat launch at any time, including the days leading up to and after the event, unless specifically approved in Event Permit.
- 3. Event Organizer is required to set up and clean up Event as identified in the Event Organizer's Event Permit. Clean up shall consistent of any and all activities necessary to restore the Event site and its surroundings to a state of appearance prior to the Event.
- 4. Event Organizer shall be responsible for ensuring the Event site is safe for the public after the Event.
- 5. Within ten business days prior to the Event, the Event Organizer shall provide the City's Park and Recreation Supervisor with final event details including, but not be limited to, estimated participants and attendance, schedule of events, and any additional information not previously provided to the City.
- 6. Within seven calendar days prior to the Event, the Event Organizer shall submit to the City a Certificate of Insurance with the required insurance minimums as specified by the City and with the City listed as an additional insured.
- 7. Event Organizer shall coordinate with City Fire, Police, and Public Works personnel in an onsite meeting scheduled by the Event Organizer with the City's designated Emergency Manager at least 72 hours prior to the event and as needed to meet the City's requirements and conditions and any other governmental agency approvals as required.
- 8. Although the City will endeavor to provide at least a seven day notice, the City's Emergency Manager has the exclusive authority to cancel the Event at any time, based on industry best practices for adverse site or weather conditions or any other public safety concerns.

- 8. Although the City will endeavor to provide at least a seven day notice, the City's Emergency Manager has the exclusive authority to cancel the Event at any time, based on industry best practices for adverse site or weather conditions or any other public safety concerns.

Re: 2024 New State Funding

The 2023 Minnesota Legislature enacted a one-time Public Safety Aid for aids payable in 2023. The one-time appropriation of \$300 million is allocated among all counties, cities, townships of a population of 10,000 or more, and Minnesota's 11 federally recognized tribal governments. The City received \$918,572 in public safety aid funding on December 26, 2023.

Eligible uses of these funds include:

- Community violence prevention and intervention programs
- Community engagement
- Mental health crisis responses
- Victim services
- Training programs
- First responder wellness
- Equipment related to fire, rescue, and emergency services
- To pay other personnel or equipment costs

Staff have had preliminary discussions on us of these funds.

Last year the state passed the Omnibus Housing Finance and Policy Bill which included financial assistance to metropolitan local government to develop and preserve affordable housing. As a result, it is estimated the City will receive the Local Affordable Housing Aid (LAHA):

FY2024	FY2025	FY2026	FY2027	
\$ 209,645	\$ 324,881	\$ 334,600	\$	344,318

LAHA payments, collected through new sales and use tax in the metro area, will be made twice a year (July 20 and December 26) and the City has three years to use the fund. Unused funds must be returned to the State though funds deposited into a local housing trust fund are considered spent.

Funds can be used for rental assistance, new construction/redevelopment and/or rehabilitation of rental or owner-occupied housing; additionally, funds can be transferred to a local housing trust fund. Each use has its own stipulations. Staff is reviewing each option and exploring opportunities for partnership with other local and state agencies and organizations that may be able to assist the City in fund distribution. Staff anticipates having more detailed analysis and recommendations for the Council discussion prior to the City's first payment distribution.
